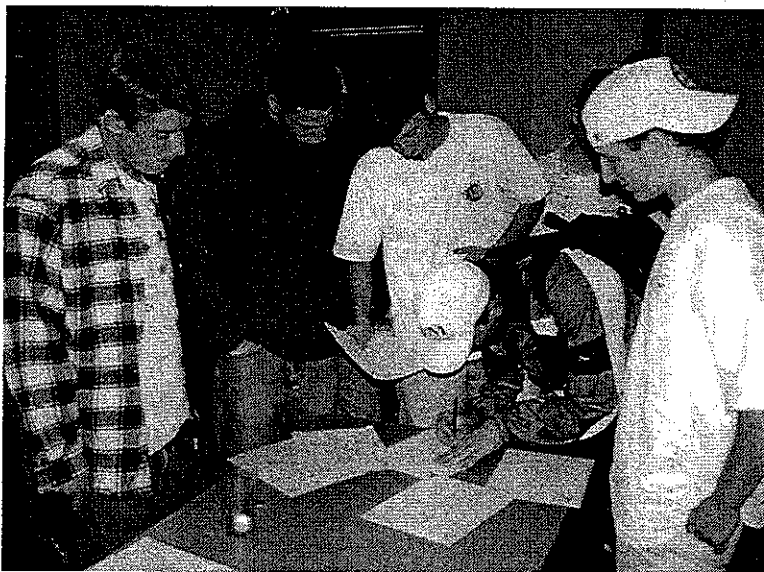


1997 Fall Rush Guide
